ORNAMENTS

Easy - Intermediate

Materials:

- #4 Medium weight yarn
- 1 small bag of poly-fill or desired stuffing
- Yarn needle
- Cable needle

Gauge is not important for this project.

You can change the size of the ornament by changing the size of knitting needles that you use, up to 5mm/US8.

Abbreviations:

- CO = cast on • K = knit • P = purl
- KFB = knit through the front and back loop; increase; knit stitch as normal but do not take off of left hand needle. Insert right hand needle into the back of the stitch and knit the back loop as well. Pull off of right hand needle.
- K2tog = knit two stitches together as one; decrease. • BO = bind off

Garter Stitch Ball

Knitting needles size 4.0mm/US6

Repeat Row 1 for all odd numbered rows unless specified.

CO 4st. Leave at least a 6" (15cm) tail at beginning.

Row 1: knit all st.

Row 2: KFB all st.

Row 4: *K1, KFB; repeat from * to end of row

Row 6: *K2, KFB; repeat from * to end of row

Row 8: *K3, KFB; repeat from * to end of row

Row 10: *K4, KFB; repeat from * to end of row

Row 12: *K8, KFB; repeat from * once, K6

Row 13-15: knit all st.

Row 16: *K8, K2tog; repeat from * to end of row

Row 18: *K4, K2tog; repeat from * to end of row

Row 20: *K3, K2tog; repeat from * to end of row

Row 22: *K2, K2tog; repeat from * to end of row

Row 24: *K1, K2tog; repeat from * to end of row

Row 26: *K2tog; repeat from * to end of row

You will have 4 stitches left on the needle.

Finishing:

Cut yarn, leaving an approximately 15" (38cm) tail. Thread yarn needle and pull yarn through remaining stitches on needle. Secure, and stitch side seam of the ball with a flat stitch. About $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way up, start stuffing with poly-fill to desired firmness. Finish seam. Tie yarn end with the tail left from cast on row to secure. To create hanging loop, tie the yarns again in an overhand knot, leaving 4-5" (10-12cm) between knots. Trim excess yarn.

Interrupted Rib Ball

Knitting needles size 4.0mm/US6

Repeat Row 3 for all odd numbered rows unless specified.

CO 8 st. Leave at least a 6" (15cm) tail at beginning.

Row 1: knit all st.

Row 2: KFB all st.

Row 3: *K1, P1; repeat from * to end of row

Row 4: *K1, KFB; repeat from * to end of row

Row 6: *K2, KFB; repeat from * to end of row

Row 8: *K3, KFB; repeat from * to end of row

Row 10: *K4, KFB; repeat from * to end of row

Row 12: *K8, KFB; repeat from * to end of row

Row 13-15: repeat row 3

Row 16: *K8, K2tog; repeat from * to end of row

Row 18: *K4, K2tog; repeat from * to end of row

Row 20: *K3, K2tog; repeat from * to end of row

Row 22: *K2, K2tog; repeat from * to end of row

Row 24: *K1, K2tog; repeat from * to end of row

Row 26: *K2tog; repeat from * to end of row

You will have 8 stitches left on the needle.

Finish as for the garter stitch ball.





Cable Sweater

Knitting needles size 3.25mm/US3

Abbreviations:

C = cable; cable pattern: slide 2st onto the cable needle, hold in front of work. K2st from left hand needle as normal. Slide the 2st from the cable needle back onto the left hand needle and knit them. (Stitches can also be knit right off of the cable needle if you wish.)

CO 10st.

Row 1: knit all st.

Row 2 purl all st.

Row 3: (cable row) K3, C, K3

Row 4: purl all st.

Row 5: knit all st.

Row 6: purl all st.

Row 7-15: repeat rows 3-6, ending with a row 3.

Row 16: CO 5st. Purl across those stitches and to end of row. CO 5st.

Row 17: knit all st.

Row 18: purl all st.

Row 19: (cable row) K8, C, K8

Row 20: purl all st.

Row 21: K7, BO 6st, K7

Row 22: P7, CO 6st, P7

Row 23: knit all st.

Row 24: purl all st.

Row 25-26: repeat row 23-24

Row 27: BO 5st, K10, BO 5st

Row 28: purl all st.

Row 29: knit all st.

Row 30-42: repeat row 28-29

Row 43: BO all st.

To add cowl neck:

Pick up 6 st at front neck edge. Knit 3 rows, then BO all st.

Repeat for the back neck edge.

Finishing:

Fold sweater in half along neck edge and with yarn needle, stitch together at underarms, sides and neck edges. Weave in all ends. Add hanging loop with extra yarn.

Striped Sweater

Knitting needles size 3.25mm/US3

Requires two colours. Will be referred to as "Colour A" and "Colour B".

Colour A

CO 10st

Row 1-2: knit all st.

Row 3: purl all st.

Row 4-9: repeat rows 2-3

Row 10: *K1 with colour A, K1 with colour B; repeat from * to end of row

Colour B

Row 11: purl all st.

Row 12: knit all st.

Row 13: purl all st.

Row 14: repeat row 10

Colour A

Row 15: purl all st.

Row 16: CO 6st, knit these st and to end of row, CO 6st

Row 17: purl all st

Row 18: knit all st

Row 19: purl all st

Row 20: K8, BO 6st, K8

Row 21: P8, CO 6st, P8

Row 22: knit all st

Row 23: purl all st

Row 24: knit all st

Row 25: BO 6 st, P10, BO 6 st

Row 26: knit all st

Row 27: purl all st

Row 28-37: repeat row 26-27

Row 38: BO all st

Finish as for the cable sweater.
